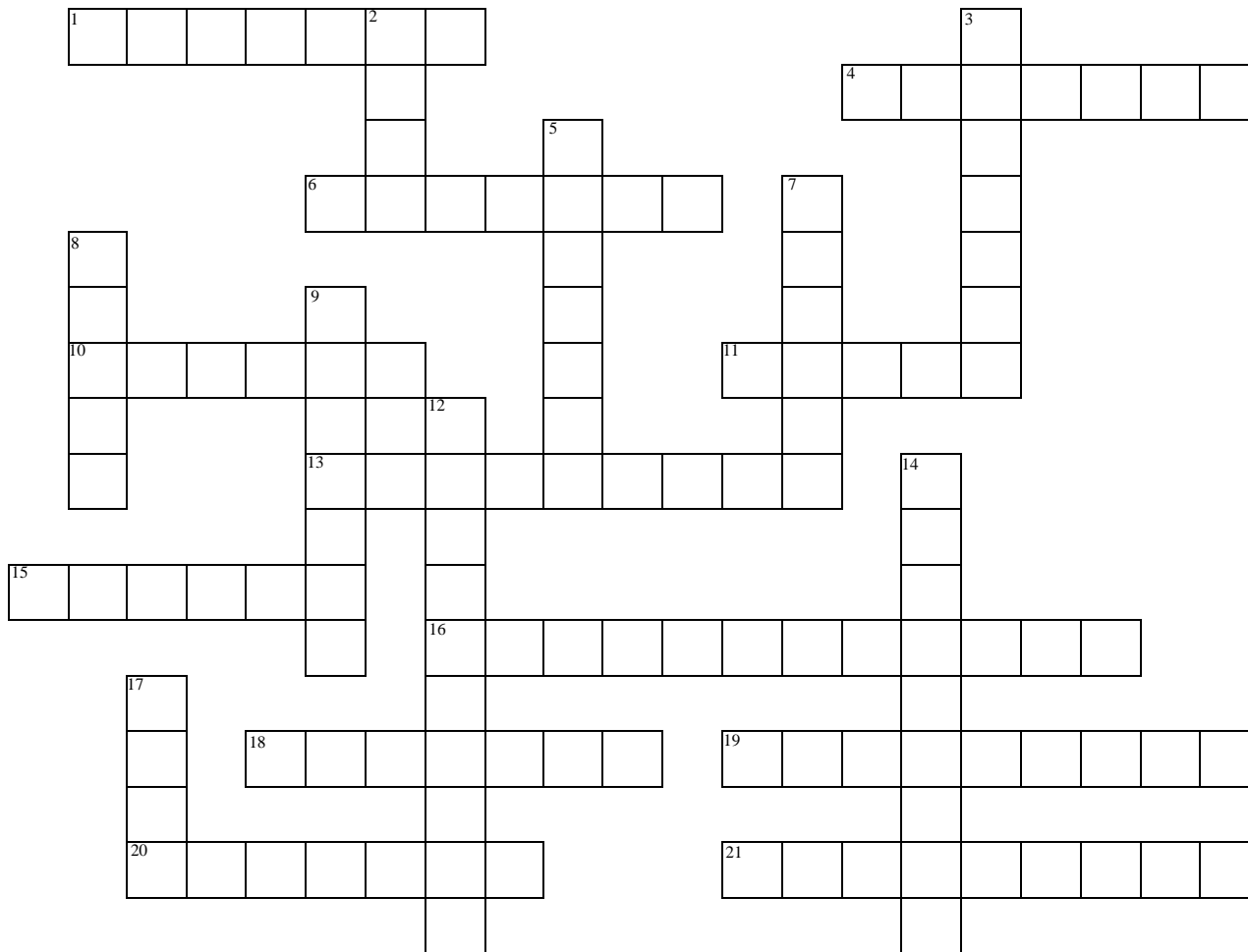


Instructions: Fill out the crossword using the hints below.



ACROSS

- 1** A series of bone which make up the skull, but excluding the mandible.
- 4** A large triangular or wing shaped bone that articulates with the humerus to make up the shoulder.
- 6** The bones of the ankle and instep
- 10** Part of the skeleton that is closer to the midline of the body.
- 11** The medial and larger bone of the lower leg.
- 13** The series of bones which make up the fingers and toes.
- 15** The side of the mouth closest to the cheek.
- 16** The normal anatomical points of contact between
- 18** Part of the skeleton that is further away from the midline of the body.
- 19** A series of bones that make up the spinal column.
- 20** A dagger shaped bone that protects the heart, commonly referred to as the breast plate.
- 21** The cheek bone.

DOWN

- 2** A long bone in the forearm which articulates with the humerus to form the elbow.
- 3** The upper jaw.
- 5** Commonly referred to as the knee cap.
- 7** The lateral bone of the lower arm
- 8** The largest bone in the human body.
- 9** Series of bones which make up the wrist.
- 12** The heel bone.
- 14** Small series of bones that crush and grind food in preparation for digestion.
- 17** A series of curved bones that protect the heart and other vital organs of the thorax.
